Inhalation : Low acute inhalation toxicity. As with exposure to high concentrations of any dust, minimal

irritation of the respiratory tract may occur. Pure carbon black and titanium dioxide, minor components of this product, has been listed by IARC as a group 2B (possible carcinogen). This classification is based on rat "lung particulate overload" studies

performed with airborne particulate. Toner is not listed by IARC, NTP, or OSHA.

**Aggravating conditions** : Exposure to high airborne dust concentrations, including toner, may aggravate existing respiratory conditions.
